HORSTMAN CANADA SUPPLIER QUALITY ASSURANCE REQUIREMENTS SQAR No. 15

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The requirement outlined below, as specified on this purchase order and subsequent amendments, forms in integral part of the purchase order between Horstman Canada Inc. and the seller. The requirement shall remain in force for the duration of this purchase order only, unless deviation is authorized in writing by Horstman Canada.

15 Age Control

- 15.1 Seller supplying adhesives, rubber, hose, hose assemblies, etc. shall mark the parts and exterior shipping container in accordance with applicable Military Specification. The date of manufacture and expiration date (quarter and year) is required as applicable. Products shall not exceed two quarters from date of manufacture to ship date and acceptance at Horstman Canada or half of shelf life, whichever is less.
- 15.2 Test data (composition of rubber and applicable physical characteristics such as ozone resistance, tension, adhesion, tear resistance, hardness, fluid immersion, etc.) must be maintained by the seller for each shipment of parts for a minimum of ten years.

Note: Rubber test data is not required when the rubber is used primarily for insulation, e.g., rubber coated (cushion clamp) clips and clamps, electrical sockets, coated wire, etc., unless specifically requested by Horstman Canada.
