SQAR No. 18

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The requirement outlined below, as specified on this purchase order and subsequent amendments, forms in integral part of the purchase order between Horstman Canada Inc. and the seller. The requirement shall remain in force for the duration of this purchase order only, unless deviation is authorized in writing by Horstman Canada.

18 Identification, Preservation, Packaging and Packing

- 18.1 The seller shall accomplish identification, cleaning, preservation, packaging and packing in accordance with the applicable drawings, specifications, and instructions as referenced on the purchase order. Where applicable, the material shall be identified as required by MIL-STD-130. In the absence of specific instructions, good commercial practice shall be used.
- 18.2 All materials, parts, or assemblies shipped direct to Horstman Canada shall be packaged or crated by the best commercial or domestic practices, in accordance with terms and conditions of the purchase order or by specific instructions issued by Horstman Canada purchasing department.
- 18.3 Unless otherwise specified, all uncoated or unprotected ferrous and nonferrous metal surfaces (internal and/or external) must be protected for thirty days against rust and corrosion and be suitably packed to prevent damage from handling or shipping.
